\_\_\_\_\_ **Are you Eligible to Vote in Vermont?**

You can vote in Vermont **ONLY** if you:

1. are a citizen of the United States;
2. are a resident of Vermont and a resident of the town in which you apply;
3. take the Voter's Oath; and
4. are 18 years of age or older
  - If you are not yet 18 years old, but will become 18 years old before the next election, the application can be completed and submitted to the Town Clerk.

## \_\_\_\_\_ **Complete the Applications for Addition to the Checklist**

**You must include your Vermont Driver's License Number on the form. If you do not have a Vermont Driver's License Number or if your license is suspended, include the last 4 digits of your Social Security Number.**

## \_\_\_\_\_ **Take the Voter's Oath in front of a notary, and have a notary sign the form**

**Any notary public, town clerk, justice of the peace, or person authorized to administer oaths in Vermont is acceptable. You cannot take the voters' oath until you are 18.**

Once it is completed you must submit the form to the Town or City Clerk in the town or city in which you reside. You will also be given an opportunity to register to vote when you register your car, get a driver's license or renew your registration or license.
